

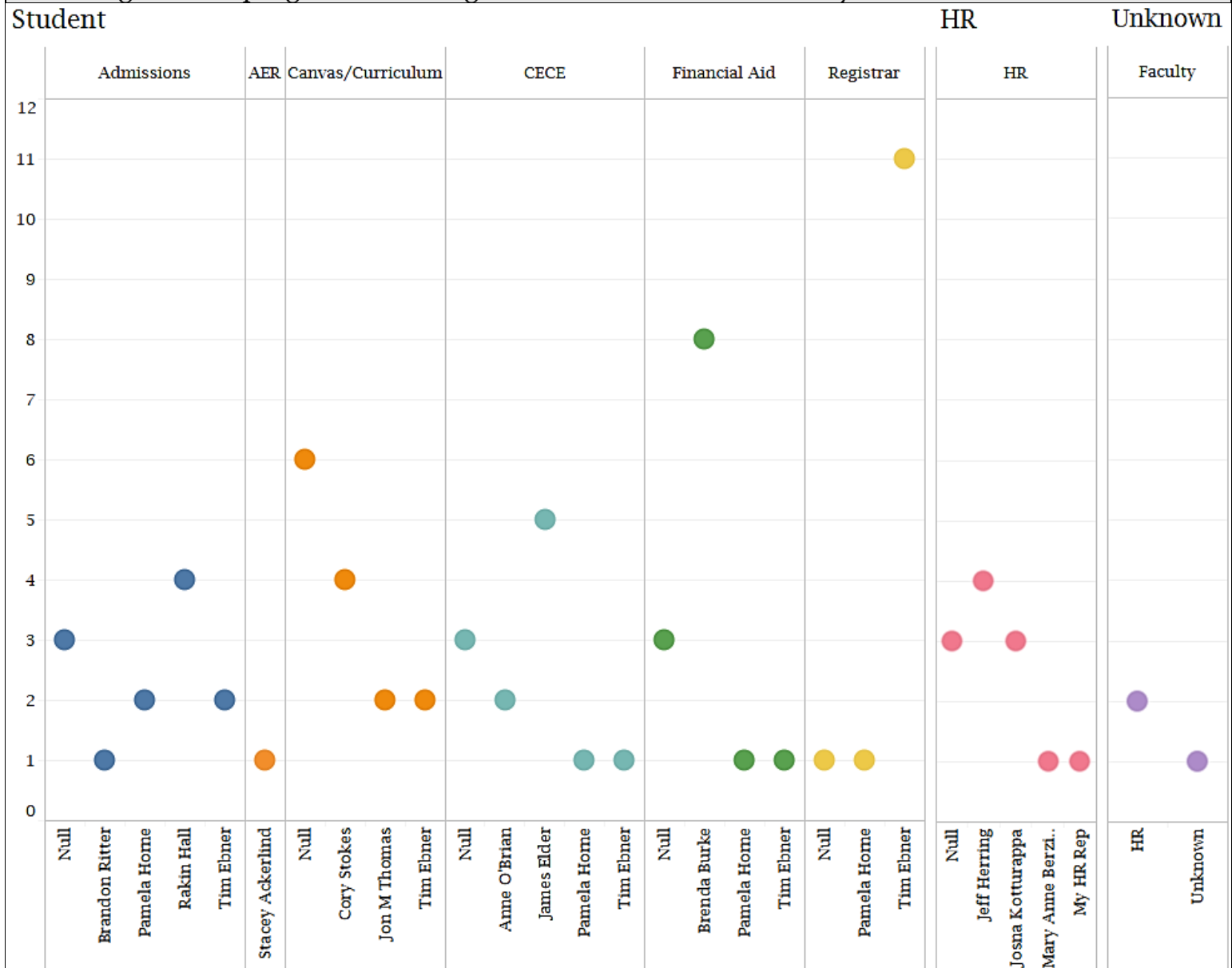

Data Stewards Mid Meeting Quiz

As I met with the different departments and individuals, one thing that really became apparent is that people want to go to the right source for data, but that “right” source isn’t always apparent. During the presentation, I handout a mid meeting quiz asking individuals to fill in who they thought where the data steward for specific areas. I received 12 worksheets back and below are the results. Our primary goals for this part of the data governance program is to understand our current state. Once we are able to understand and articulate our current state, we can begin having conversations with the VPs and core stakeholders to establish our strategy and ensure that we grow this program according to the needs of the university.



It has been noted in follow-up conversations that like AER and faculty, student finances should also be added as an area that may require a data steward.

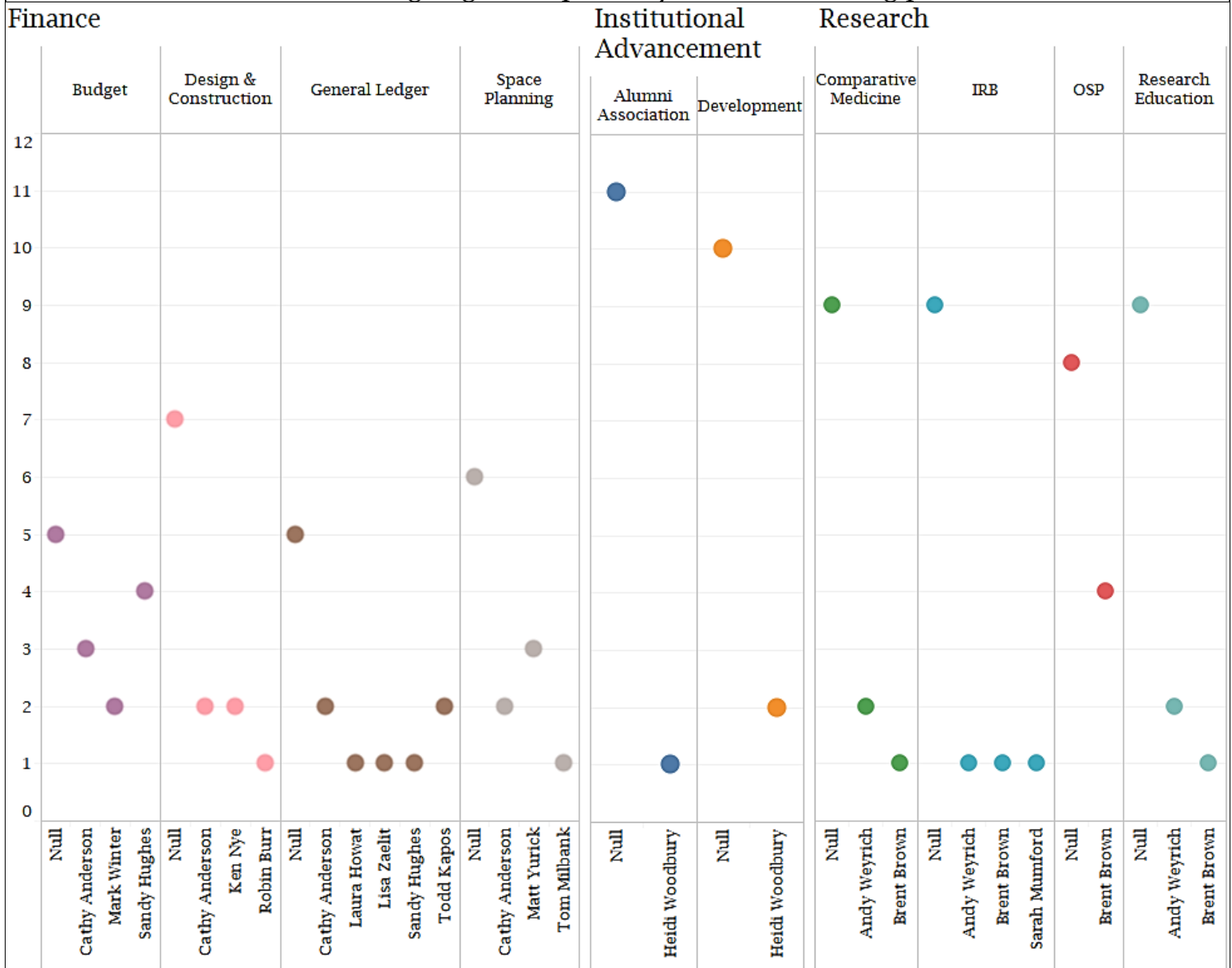
